

# AFTON FAIR DEMO DERBY

## JULY 24, 2011

- A. Each driver must fill out an entry blank. All drivers must supply their own cars.
- B. **Drivers between 16 and 18 years of age must hold a valid driver's license.**
- C. The promoter reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
- D. Only owners, drivers, mechanics who sign the release sheet will be permitted in the pit area. (Driver receives pit pass upon registration of car on show day). No one under the age of 18 allowed in the pit area unless a registered driver. Pit passes are \$10.
- E. Contestants of the derby are not employees of the track, fair association or the promoter of the **Afton Fair Demolition Derby.**
- F. **(The promoter, track owners or Fair Association will not be held responsible for any cars, parts or personal injury or property before, during and after the show or overnight)**

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**TYPE OF CAR—Any stock, hardtop automobile or station wagon is allowed. No trucks, convertibles, jeeps, hearses, imperials or limousines are allowed. All sunroofs must be covered with metal or tin.**

### PREPARATION OF CAR

1. **All glass and fragments must be removed including tail lamps and head lamps. Rolling windows down is not permitted.**
2. **Chrome molding and all door and trunk locks must be removed. Entire rear seat must be removed but front passenger seat must remain in original position.**
3. Any sharp protruding objects must be mashed down or cut off.
4. No special bumpers, reinforcement, fabrications or trailer hitches permitted. Bumpers can be welded to bumper plates; bumper shocks may be welded. Must have hole drilled in bumper shock. No extra metal can be added.
5. Radiators must remain in engine compartment. **Antifreeze must be removed.** Transmission coolers may be moved to rear seat area enclosed in a metal box and have steel lines.
6. Roll-over bars and halo bars are not permitted. A 4 way cage can be used but cannot be welded to the frame. Must be safely assembled. A bar is mandatory behind driver's seat welded to the inside of car (from door post to door post) to a metal plate 6"x 6"x 1/4" thick.
7. **All doors must be chained or wired for drivers' safety. No chains larger than 1/4". Trunks and hoods may have up to 4 chains no longer than 24". Driver's door only may be welded.**
8. **One or two automobile batteries may be used.** If battery is removed from original position, it must be placed on passenger's side of driver's compartment. Battery must be secured and covered with a rubber mat.
9. Cutting fenders and bumper ends for clearance only is permitted. No bolting of fenders. Maximum bumper height of 24".
10. Hood and trunk lid shocks and struts must be removed; Hood and trunk must be fastened with chains or cables, **BUT MUST BE OPENED FOR INSPECTION.**
11. Your number must be painted on both front doors and roof (3 ft. white circle with black legible number). **Entire driver's door must be white.**
12. **Cars must be swept clean. No glass or debris.**

13. **Stock Gas Tanks** may remain in original place if in front of rear axle. If tank is not in front of rear axle it must be removed and placed over rear axle no further forward than where the rear seat was removed. All tanks must be securely fastened and covered with an adequate fire wall (tin, steel, metal, etc.). A portable tank is recommended in place of the original but must be DOT approved. No gas cans or propane tanks. (Approximately 4 gallons of gas). Electric fuel pumps must have a manual kill switch within the officials reach if fuel tank and lines are not left in original position.
14. Cars must be inspected at least one hour before show time, 1:00 p.m. (Gates will be closed at 12:00 p.m.) Gates open at 10:00 a.m. for demo cars. **No exceptions.**
15. It is mandatory that an opening be cut in the center of the hood approximately 8" and we recommend a shield between driver and opening.
16. Tires must be D.O.T. approved on no more than 5 lug rims. No double tires or liquids permitted. No studs or screws in rims to hold the tires. Wheel weights must be removed. Only non aggressive tires on main drive wheels.
17. A strong wire or nylon mesh is recommended on driver's front and side windows and there must be two bars bolted in center of windshield opening from roof to engine compartment. Bars must be at least 1/2" or larger and 12" apart.
18. If body mounts are removed you cannot use bolts or threaded rod larger than 5/8" and no washers larger than 3" x 1/4 "max thickness. No extra holes may be added.
19. No obscene language written on auto (Thank You).
20. The promoter reserves the right to reject or refuse entry of a vehicle or personnel. **The officials' ruling is final on any decisions.**

#### **RUNNING RULES**

1. Safety belt, Z-90 approved helmet, goggles or face shields are required.
2. Drivers will be disqualified for **intentionally** hitting of driver's door.
3. **Vehicle must have dependable brakes at all times (will be checked) and boundaries must be observed and anyone crossing white lines may be disqualified.**
4. No drinking of alcoholic beverages on track, emergency vehicle area or in the pit area. Any driver or pit person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be immediately disqualified and removed from the grounds.
5. No cars permitted in the **competition area** before the heat in which they are to participate or before show time.
6. If the driver's door comes open you will be disqualified.
7. One-minute time limit is enforced by the track officials for re-starts and making competitive contact with another car. Hits must be aggressive. Simple contact within the time limit does not constitute combat and could be considered sandbagging. **(Sandbagging is definitely grounds for disqualification).**
8. All cars must be removed from the grounds after the show. **We will not be responsible for any car during or after the show. Any cars left on the grounds as of 6:00 p.m. July 25 will become property of the Afton Fair Association and will be disposed of by them. You are responsible for your own vehicle at all times.**
9. No tipping of cars (if you want parts, take whole car).
10. A \$25.00 protest fee is required to contest another car.
11. **All winners will be reinspected, violators will be disqualified.** The 1<sup>st</sup> place winner in the Main feature will receive \$750.00. The 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner in Main feature will receive \$350.00 (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in the heats will also receive prize money).
